What is a Callout? What can be worn at a Callout?

Modified June 16, 2020 (Initial release July 1, 2019)

Here are just some examples:

- A Callout could be a Funeral for a fallen Knight
- A Callout could be marching in a parade, approved by the Master
- A Callout could be a Blue/Red/White Mass
- A Callout could be at a Mass where the principal celebrant is the Bishop
- A Callout could be at a Mass when asked by the local Pastor
- A Callout could be presenting colors at a local school or Community event

Note: The term callout has not changed, only what can be worn.

Here is what has been approved:

- The new uniform, with service baldric, sword & white gloves
- Alternately a tuxedo or solid black/dark blue suit would can be worn, white long sleeve dress shirt, no cuff links, no button down collar, black\dark tie, with social baldric under coat, white gloves
- Black Face Mask when a Face Mask is required due to local requirements

Note: All Patriotic Members that want to take part in a Call-Out, are allowed to participate by following the guidelines defined above. Name badges are permitted on Tuxedo & Black/Dark Suits only and NO Sword, unless you are wearing the Correct Uniform.
