Requirements for Eligibility

If you're reading this, you are obviously interested in our scholarship. There are some qualifications you need to meet, and rules you will need to follow to qualify. The following are the requirements for eligibility for our scholarship program.

- Student must be a senior in high school.
- Student must provide and attach academic grades transcripts for the final two years of high school.
- Students shall provide and attach three letters of reference; one from a family member and two from individuals not related to the applicant.
- Student must be committed to attending college or a certified technical school for the semester following his or her graduation from high school.
- Student or student's family must be registered with Our Divine Savior parish and be a practicing member of the Catholic faith.
- The student must describe in the application the reasons why they are submitting the application, and the name of the institution they plan to attend.
- Awarded scholarship funds shall be forwarded to the college or technical school in the name of the awarded recipient for the Fall semester.
