My Brothers,

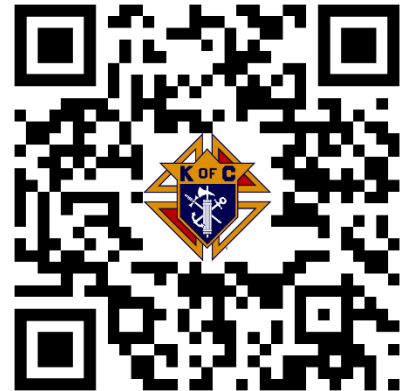

I truly hope the season was everything you wished it to be – a time spent with family and friends rejoicing in the birth of Our Savior. As we begin the new year, let us be ever mindful of our devotion to living the Gospel of Christ, and celebrating His presence among us.



There are many reasons to rejoice in the new year! First and foremost, is the success of the *Cor* (Latin for “Heart”) bible study being held by two councils (and now a third) in District 2. Councils 1137 at St. John the Baptist Church and Council 13765 at Our Divine Savior Church (both located in Chico) have combined forces to hold ***Cor* meetings on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM in Room 2 of the ODS Social Hall.** Led by Brother Rob Holt from Council 1137, brother Knights and men of the parish alike are invited to attend. Those participating have just completed an eight part reflection on “Mary, The Bible and the Mother of God” published by the Augustine Institute. Focusing on scripture, prayer and fraternity, the goal of each *Cor* gathering is to provide the opportunity for men to encounter Christ, to pray together, and to be

formed in their faith. Council 7773 at St. Thomas More Church in Paradise (the third council in District 2 to adopt *Cor*) is also holding Men’s Ministry bible study meetings under the leadership of Deacon Tom O’Connell on Friday of each week at 7:00 AM in their new social hall.

The Supreme Council continues to promote online membership as an easy way to get qualified Catholic men of the parish involved in your council quickly.
