SPIRITUAL ADVISOR:

From the Seventeenth to the Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

On the Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B, we temporarily set aside Mark's Gospel in order to read in John's the account of the multiplication of the loaves and, for four Sundays, the discourse on the Bread of Life.

When, at the end of the discourse on the Bread of Life, Simon Peter proclaims, in the name of the Twelve, his unshakable attachment to Jesus, we should be thinking of the solemn renewal of the faithfulness to the covenant that took place at the time of Joshua, at the great gathering of the twelve tribes of Israel.

During this long sequence, placed in the middle of Ordinary Time, Year B, we should be progressing at a rhythm quite different from that of the preceding and following passages. With Mark, we are constantly

moving; it is quite another thing with these five Sundays. Having left the shore of the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus multiplied the loaves and fishes, we remain in Capernaum. But the difference does not stop here.

The discourse on the Bread of Life develops as if in a spiral. We often have the impression of not progressing, even of going backwards, of hearing repeatedly what has already been said.


