GRAND KNIGHT'S NOTATIONS

Exciting news! We are growing and recovery is happening at St. Thomas More (STM). It's hard to miss the construction of the "New" Hall, which is being built by Slater and Son of Butte County. The Hall is in-line with Slater's philosophy on constructing vital community assets with unwavering quality. The Slater Family has a legacy of philanthropy and civic engagement within the community and is actively involved in youth development and empowerment and contributes to organizations like the Boys and Girls Clubs, CSU-Chico and Business Support for the local area. "It was a good choice to have Slater and Son construct our Hall," said Greg Kidder, STM Parish Steward.

Greg mentioned that it was important to be able to meet our current needs, but "when planning the Hall, I had to look fifty or more years into the future, because needs change with time." Kidder went on to say, the new Hall is double in size to the previous Hall, allowing us to have a meeting room, classroom, storage and a kitchen--similar to what we had in the previous Hall. New add-on features are a "Grand" entry portico, expanded restrooms, professional sized custodian closet and lots and lots of cabinet space, also, we will have a loading dock, to help us load and unload equipment and supplies and carpet to help quiet the space--features that were missing in the last building.

The bulk of construction will be complete this coming October 2024 with occupancy expected to happen from October thru November. "It's right on time for us," explained Kidder, "We've been doing so much with so little, and it's been hard. The Knights and parishioners will enjoy what this new building will bring to us and the community."

March is the month of Lent – commemorating the 40 days Jesus Christ spent fasting in the desert and enduring temptation by Satan. It was a precursor to his public ministry, and a time we can use to renew our devotion to Christ and His Gospels as we journey with him in the desert. It is a period of reflection and self-examination that necessarily ends with the great celebration of Easter!

March is also traditionally the month for membership drives. Founder's Day, the day Father McGivney created the Knights of Columbus at St. Mary's Church in New Haven, Connecticut, is generally recognized and celebrated on March 29. Each year we attempt to recruit new members around that date in commemoration of the Order's anniversary. Ask your Pastor if you can hold a membership drive one weekend in March or April. Set up an information table outside the church and invite parishioners to join at all the Masses.

As an even more powerful recruiting tool, membership continues to be free to those joining online. By entering the code "BlessedMcGivney" in the online application found on the Supreme Council website at **kofc.org/joinus**, first-year membership dues are waived. The "QR" code accompanying this article, when scanned with the camera on a smartphone, will take you directly to the online membership application.

When members join online, welcome them into your council by having them attend a Combined Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity. An online member counts as a new member when they join your council. Please share your exemplification dates with me and the other councils in the district so they can participate too if they have candidates waiting.
