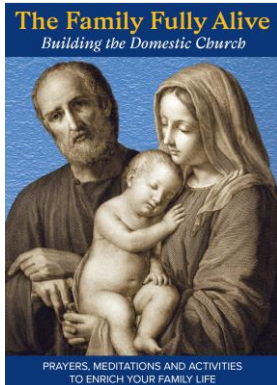


## District Deputy Report February 2026

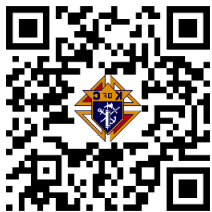
My Brothers,

Be sure and enter your membership number in the appropriate line on the application so you get credit for the recruitment.

Those who sign up online will immediately begin receiving emails, *Columbia Magazine* and a membership card allowing them to attend council meetings. They can easily be moved into a council if accepted by a vote of the membership and by participating in a ceremony of Charity, Unity and Fraternity.
