

District Deputy Report November 2025

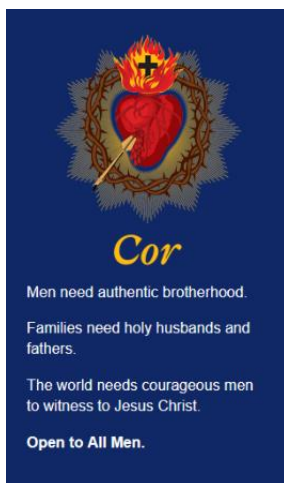
My Brothers,

Hold a church or council food drive and ensure there is sufficient supply to meet the seasonal demand. For every \$500 or 1,000 pounds of food donated, the Supreme Council will refund \$100 back to the council – up to a maximum of \$500 per council per fraternal year.
